Carrier Collaborates with Habitat for Humanity Japan to Create Green Space for Children's Home

TOKYO, May 21, 2025 – Volunteers from Carrier Japan, in collaboration with Habitat for Humanity Japan (HFHJ), recently participated in a tree-planting event at Kodomo no Sono, a children's home situated in Chigasaki City, Kanagawa Prefecture, Japan. Carrier Japan is a part of Carrier Global Corporation (NYSE: CARR), global leader in intelligent climate and energy solutions.

A team of 25 volunteers joined this event, planting 24 trees around the facility to create a greener, healthier and more vibrant space to the facility's playground and preserve biodiversity of the community. To support the growth of these trees, bamboo harvested from within the premises was repurposed into natural stakes. In line with biodiversity conservation efforts, four native species were selected for their ability to thrive in shaded areas and offer seasonal color variation.

This initiative is part of a multi-year project launched by HFHJ to create an outdoor playground where children from the facility and the surrounding community can play, connect, and grow together. The outdoor space will serve as a welcoming environment to foster interaction among young people and provide for those from the surrounding community. Inspired with the initiative, Carrier has pledged its continued support and their volunteers have participated in several rounds of activities, leveling the ground and building a brick oven for camping activities
