**Carrier Promotes Sustainable Forest Conservation
with Local Communities at the Foot of Mt. Fuji**

TOKYO, May 28, 2026 – Carrier again participated in forest conservation initiatives in Shizuoka Prefecture and Fuji City, Japan, where the company’s manufacturing and R&D bases are located. In April, employees took part in two volunteer activities aimed at supporting local environmental preservation efforts. Through these initiatives, Carrier Japan reaffirms its commitment to conserving and restoring the natural environment in the regions where it operates, while contributing to broader efforts to protect the global environment. In addition to the projects in Japan, Carrier recently announced its global progress toward its commitment with the Arbor Day Foundation to [plant 5 million trees by 2030](#). In 2025, the company funded the planting of 1,009,514 trees, primarily in regions facing significant environmental challenges.

“Environmental conservation is a key priority for Carrier. We see great value in continuing these hands-on activities in collaboration with local communities to preserve and restore forest ecosystems,” said Mineo Maruyama, President, Carrier Japan. “These efforts reflect Carrier’s purpose—“Enhancing the lives we live and the world we share”—and underscore its continued commitment to environmental stewardship. By steadily building on these efforts, we remain committed to contributing to a more sustainable society.”

In Japan, Carrier continues to engage in forest conservation activities in collaboration with local communities. On April 21, employees cleared underbrush at the future “Learning Forest” project site at the foot of Mt. Fuji. Despite the rain, participants carried out weed cutting and disposal, contributing to maintaining a healthy forest environment.



Carrier Japan has been an active participant in the “Shizuoka Future Forest Supporter” program, and in 2018—marking over 10 years of continuous engagement—received a commendation from Shizuoka Prefecture.

In addition, on April 29, Carrier volunteers participated in the 33rd Mt. Fuji Foothills Beech Forest Creation Project organized in Fuji City. At the former Minami-Fuji Country Club site, employees planted native trees, including beech, as part of efforts to preserve and restore the rich natural environment of the Mt. Fuji foothills. The initiative also aims to pass on biodiversity and vital water conservation functions to future generations. On the day, approximately 2,000 native seedlings—such as beech, zelkova, stewartia,

Japanese maple, konara oak, dogwood and Fuji cherry—were planted. The event marked Carrier Japan's 18th year of participation in the program.



Each employee planted approximately 10 trees. After the planting activities, a commemorative photo was taken with Fuji City Mayor Yuki Kanazashi.
